### Marion County Springs Festival Student Art Contest Rules

- Student art should represent the theme: “Preserving Marion County Springs Through Awareness & Stewardship.”
- Artwork must be **two-dimensional**, maximum size 12-by-18 inches, and must be mounted on a flat panel for viewing. Three-dimensional art will not be accepted. Photos are not permitted.
- All entries must have visible, white labels on the **front** with student name (first and last), school, teacher and grade. Labels of home school students should have: Home School Association, student name, grade, parent/guardian name, phone number and mailing address.
- **Submit entries by Wednesday, Sept. 16**, to Ruth Dexheimer at Madison Street Academy of Visual & Performing Arts, 401 Martin Luther King Blvd, Ocala, or to Maricelli Roberts at Dunnellon Library, 20351 Robinson Road, by Thursday, Sept. 17. - Each school may submit up to three entries per grade level.
- Four 1<sup>st</sup>-place winners (one K-2, one grade 3-5, one middle school and one high school student) each will receive a \$50 gift card.
- All artwork will be exhibited at the Dunnellon Library on Friday and Saturday, Sept. 18-19, and the Headquarters of Marion County Public Library, 2720 E. Silver Springs Blvd, Ocala, Sunday and Monday, Sept. 20-21, during library hours. Students, families and friends are invited to judge art until 6 p.m. on Monday, when votes will be tallied. Ribbons will be posted by 6:30 p.m. and artwork will be removed at 7:30 p.m.
- All artwork will be displayed at the 8<sup>th</sup> Annual Marion County Springs Festival at Rainbow Springs State Park, U.S. 41, Dunnellon, on Saturday, Sept. 26.
